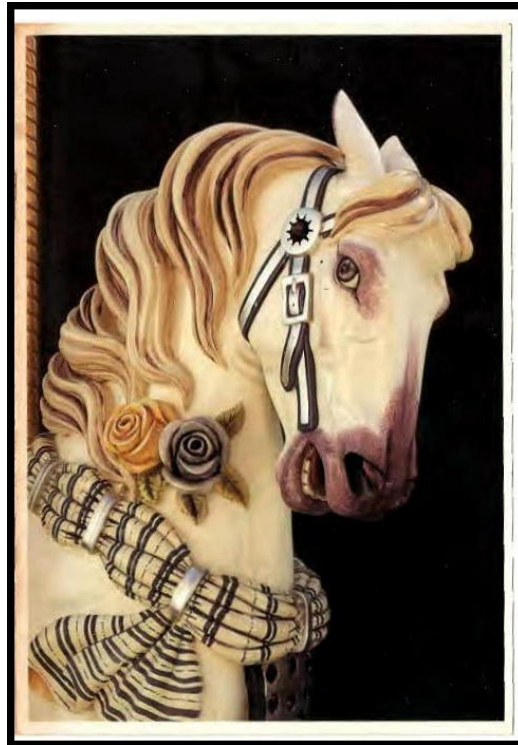


BIRTHDAY CARD TO BARBARA



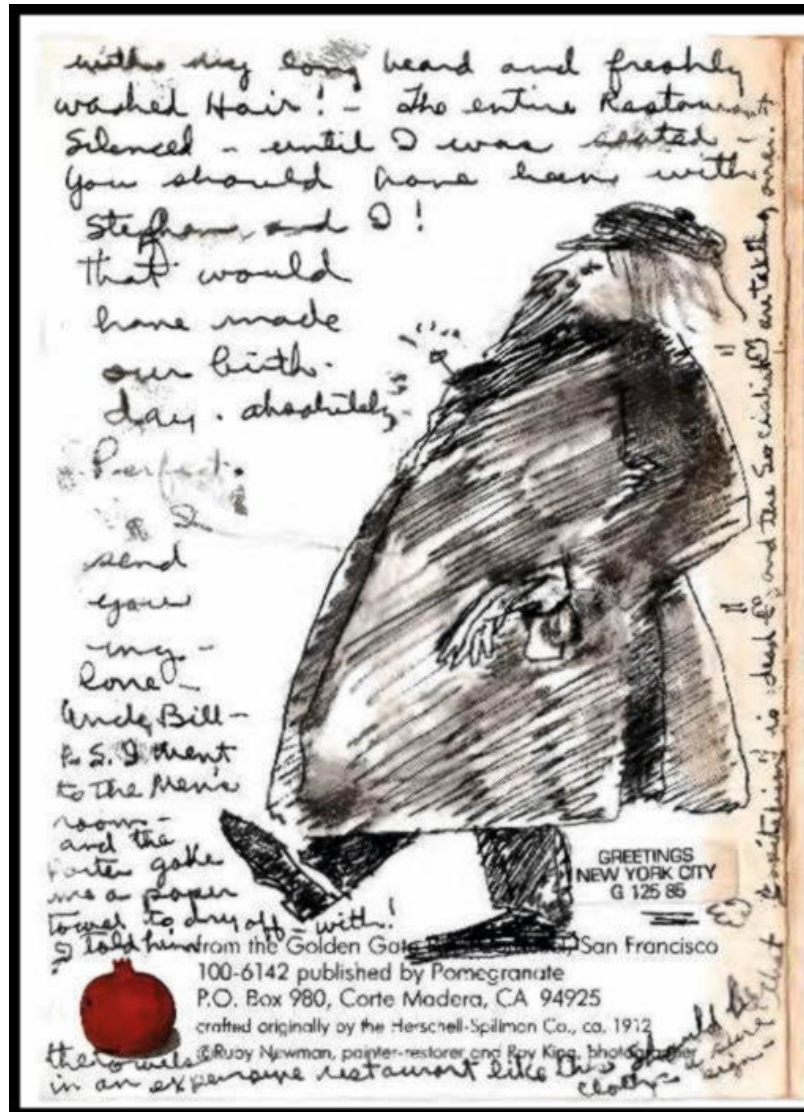
Front – Uncle Bill always appreciated my love of horses...
